DIRECTIONS & PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

Our site address is: Kenwood House, Hampstead Lane, Highgate, London, NW3 7JR. Parking is available at East Lodge Gate.

If you are travelling by train, the nearest stations are Gospel Oak and Hampstead Heath.

There is very limited parking at West Lodge Gate (reserved for disabled users) so please use public transport when you can.

If you are travelling by underground, disembark at Golders Green or Archway before taking the 210 Bus.

PLEASE NOTE:

Train Strikes will be taking place on 1st October and services are likely to be cancelled or severely disrupted. Please plan your journey in advance and check the National Rail website for an updated timetable here -
