Ticket & Box Office

All Ticket Holders will need to collect their wristbands from the Arrivals Tent at our festival.

- To collect your wristband you will need your confirmation code (LK____) which can be found within your confirmation email.
 - If you cannot find your confirmation code, please email enquiries@artandideas.org
 - If you hold a Student and U25s Ticket please bring appropriate ID which will be checked on wristband collection. If purchased via English Heritage please bring proof of membership.

Your Festival Wristband will grant you unlimited access to the site and all events in our core programme.

• Festival Tickets and Day Festival Tickets **do not** provide access to Extra Experiences which are ticketed. These include Long Table Banquets and Inner Circle events with speakers. To book Extra Experiences, please head to our website or the Box Office.

Fast Passes:

If you want to secure the best seat and skip the long queue at your favourite debates or talks, you can pick up a Fast Pass for £8 at the Box Office.

Getting to the Festival & Our Festival Site

HowTheLightGetsIn London 2025 is located in the immediate grounds of Kenwood House. You can use the following to locate our site:

Train/TfL:

- Our nearest stations are Gospel Oak and Hampstead Heath
- The 210 bus will take you directly to Kenwood House.

Parking:

• There is *very* limited parking at West Lodge Gate Car Park. This is predominantly reserved for those with Blue Badges (check our Accessibility Arrangements if you'd like to reserve this), so please do use Public Transport.

Cycling:

- There are limited places to park bicycles.
- Please do not secure them to the rails around Kenwood House.

 Wellington or vegan Wellington with seasonal sides, and classic desserts of tiramisu or vegan espresso crème caramel.

Set in its own tent, this is a remarkable chance to meet speakers informally over a meal and a glass of wine. Accessibility

At HowTheLightGetsIn, we strive to ensure that everyone can enjoy the event, so we try our best to make the festival site as accessible as possible.

Festival Site

HowTheLightGetsIn takes place in the grounds of Kenwood House. The area is predominantly grass, with limited hard standing pathways. In the event of bad weather, mud and puddles are likely.

There will be some hardened pathways covering the main walking routes through the site, but just as we prepare for all conditions we do ask that you do to. So please consider the ground conditions and unpredictable British weather when deciding what facilities, you may need and what equipment you need to bring.

We will of course have dedicated Disabled Toilets - location TBC closer to the time of the festival. Please ask our friendly Box Office staff for details.

Car Park Access

There will be an on-site car park with dedicated Disabled spaces.

Personal Assistant / Carer Ticket

We provide a free ticket for a personal assistant or carer to ticket holders who would be unable to attend, or those whose experience would be greatly impaired without their presence.

Service Dogs & ESAs

The festival recognises and welcomes accredited guide dogs & assistance dogs which have been trained by a member of the International Guide Dog Federation (IGDF) or Assistance Dogs International (ADI). HowTheLightGetsIn requests that all festival goers who wish to bring their accredited guide & assistance dogs provide their ID card or certificate issued by the training organisation on entry. If you do not currently have official documentation, we kindly ask that you pre-register your animal to avoid any confusion at the box office.

Emotional Support Animals (ESAs) must be pre-registered before the festival. Only ESAs with prior approval from the HowTheLightGetsIn team will be permitted on site and our team reserves the ability to deny access to festival goers without pre-registered ESAs. To pre-register your ESA, please email enquiries@artandideas.org

All animals permitted to enter our festival site will be given a tag by the box office to ensure identification is possible by on-site staff. All festival goers are responsible for managing and controlling the hygiene and welfare of their animal whilst on-site.

Tent Access

All those with disabilities or less able to stand will not need to queue to enter a venue and will not need to purchase Fast Passes for disability access. Please speak to our Stewards on the door of each venue.
