Tickets:

All ticket holders will need to collect their tickets from the Arrivals Tent at the festival.

Please bring your email confirmation code with you. If you hold a Student or U25s ticket, please bring appropriate ID

Directions & Public Transport:

Our site address is: Kenwood House, Hampstead Lane, Highgate, London, NW3 7JR.

Parking is available at East Lodge Gate.

If you are travelling by train, the nearest stations are Gospel Oak and Hampstead Heath.

There is very limited parking at West Lodge Gate (reserved for disabled users) so please use public transport when you can.

There are very limited places to park bicycles, please do not secure them to the rails around Kenwood House.

If you are travelling by underground, disembark at Golders Green or Archway before taking the 210 Bus.

What to Bring:

Festival programmes will be available on site. The print programme includes a timetable of all events throughout the festival weekend, as well as site maps, speaker and artist biographies etc. Please check the chalkboard in the Box Office for any programme changes or use our online programme which you can find here
